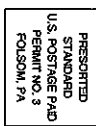

Ridley Recreation Happenings outlines all the programs planned by the Recreation Department for the summer of 2010. We have expanded our daily playground activities to include different arts and crafts each week and a movie day. We have worked hard to improve each playground site. The sites this year include: Backstreet Park, Mill Playground, Edgewood School, Amiesland School, and Leeson Community Hall. The summer playground program will begin on June 21st and continue to July 30th. The playgrounds will be open Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

We will have our annual trips to the Philadelphia Zoo, Franklin Institute, CN Skate Palace and Herr's Potato Chip Factory. If you have any questions concerning any of our programs, please contact Peter J. O'Keefe, Director, Parks and Recreation at 610-522-0557. We have included the Ridley Twp. Public Library's Summer Program. For library program information please call the library directly at (610) 383-0583.

We ask that you pre-register your children for the playground program at the Ridley Township Municipal Building or by mail. This enables us to properly staff each playground location. Consents will not be permitted to accept registrations or payments at the camps. Children must be five years old by June 15, 2010 to be eligible for our playground program due to insurance regulations. If your child is not registered in the Ridley School District we will need to see their birth certificate.

We also ask that if you are interested in our field trips that you register early so that we can obtain enough buses. The trips fill up fast so please do not delay.

There will be a special evening registration for the summer camps on June 15th at the Ridley Township Community Center from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm. If you would prefer to register by mail, please complete the registration form on this newsletter and take it to the Recreation Department, 100 E. MacDade Blvd., Folsom, PA 19033. Please make all checks payable to "Ridley Township". You may register daily at the Township building from 9am to 4pm.

THE RIDLEY TOWNSHIP SUMMER PLAYGROUND PROGRAM

The playground program will start on Monday, June 21, 2010 and will continue until July 30, 2010. The camps will be open Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. excluding July 26, 2010. There will be an experienced senior counselor to supervise each location. Each day will consist of arts and crafts, athletic and non-athletic games. There will also be coordinated games between various playgrounds. We will hold a Fun Day on July 28th at Ridley Community Center. This year there will be a nominal fee for our playground program. It will be \$30.00 per participant or \$50.00 per family. This will enable us to enhance our already existing programs.

- The proposed playgrounds for children ages five to twelve will be at the following locations:
- 1) Edgewood School
 - 2) Backstreet Park
 - 3) Amiesland School
 - 4) Leeson Community Hall

In order to prepare for proper staffing at these locations, we are asking you to register as soon as possible. Either mail or drop-off the registration to the Ridley Township Municipal Building at 100 E. MacDade Blvd., Folsom from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday. We ask that you respond quickly. If anyone can provide transportation to our special events, it would be greatly appreciated.

Since our program is an outdoor program, with the equipment stored in school buildings, the playgrounds will be CLOSED when the weather is inclement. Call 610-522-0557 and listen to message.

We have added four trips to our program in an effort to offer additional programs to our children. We welcome any parent willing to take a trip with us. Children must be registered in our Summer Program, or there is an additional \$10.00 charge. We ask you to sign up early, as we need to schedule the buses.

We will leave the Township Municipal Building parking lot and return to the same location. The return trip times are approximate. There are food services available at each location or you are welcome to pack a snack and/or lunch for your child.
